## Family FAQs

**Q: Can I use an expired IEP or Service Plan to apply?**

**A:** At this time, each student must have a currently dated IEP, Service Plan or CSEP to be considered eligible. If your plan has expired, please contact your local school corporation to request an evaluation.

**Q: I have registered on the website, and I am trying to log in. What is my username?**

**A:** The username is (YourstudentsSTN#)@(Youremaildomain). For example if the STN was 123456789 and you used a Gmail email address to register your username would be 123456789@gmail.com.
